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HARDSHIP EXTENSION FOR DELINQUENT TAXES FACING FORECLOSURE

Persons facing foreclosure because they have not paid their 2007 property taxes may be eligible for a hardship extension.

There are many factors taken into consideration, but here are a few general guidelines:

- * The property must be the homestead of the person seeking the hardship.
- * The total household income should not exceed 150% of the federal poverty level.
- * Are you receiving the Principal Residence Exemption on your property taxes?
- * Are you eligible for, and have you received your property tax credit from the State of Michigan (MI1040-CR)?

There are also many agencies that may be able to offer one-time assistance. Please contact The Monroe County Treasurer at (734) 240-7365, for an appointment to review your case, if you think you may qualify for a one-year hardship extension.

This is only an extension, it will postpone the payment of the tax facing foreclosure for up to one year, but the tax is still due, and interest will continue to accrue.
